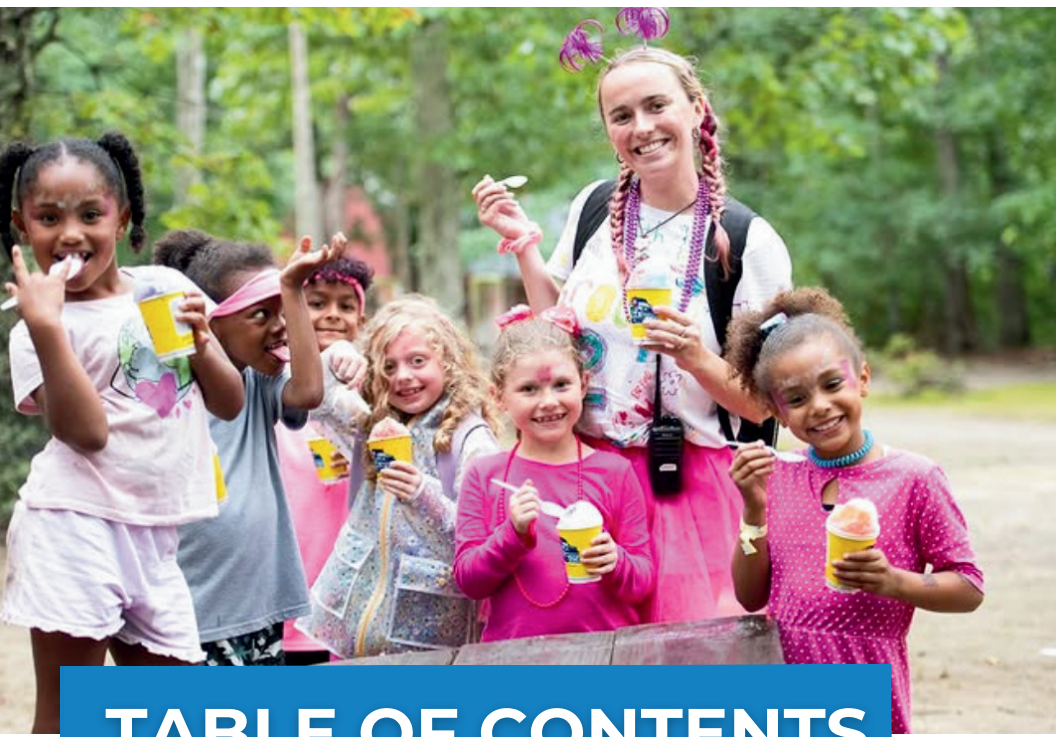

PACKING LIST

> WHAT TO BRING/WEAR TO CAMP

Please send your child with the following every day (clearly marked with their name in waterproof marker)

- Backpack
- Sunscreen/bug repellent
- Reusable water bottle
- Sneakers (please, no open-toed shoes or sandals — our program is very active, and we do not want your child’s feet/ankles hurt! (Crocs are allowed)
- Comfortable clothing
- Bathing suit and towel
- Water shoes (we swim where there are oysters, rocks, and crabs—which run the risk of feet getting cut)



For rainy days: raincoat and rain boots. For chilly days: sweatshirt, windbreaker, or long pants.

⚠ WE ARE A NUT FREE CAMP

Please do not send any peanut or nut products. We serve breakfast and lunch daily. You're welcome to send additional food, especially if your camper has specific dietary needs.

BEHAVIORS AND EXPECTATIONS

At Camp Grosvenor, safety is our priority. To ensure all campers have a fun and meaningful experience, we abide by the following Camp Rules.



> CAMP RULES

1. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself. Unwanted physical contact of any kind is not permitted.
2. Use kind and appropriate language at all times.
3. Stay with your group, stay on paths, and never leave camp property.
4. Listen to counselors and follow directions.
5. Respect the environment — no littering; leave sticks, rocks, and similar items on the ground unless part of a program.
6. **Cell phones are not allowed.** We want campers present and engaged.
7. Leave all animals and wildlife alone.
8. Play safely and fairly.



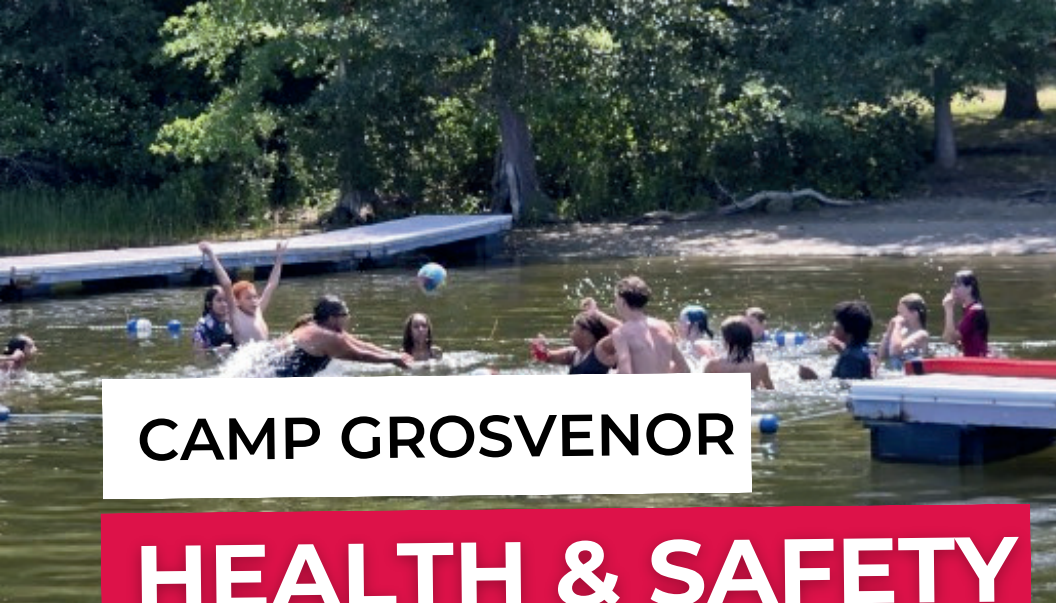
> DISCIPLINE & ANTI-BULLYING

Every camper is entitled to a safe, positive camp experience. Physical or verbal bullying — including behavior that inflicts emotional harm, abuses staff, and/or persistently disrupts the program — will not be tolerated. Serious offenses, including bullying, fighting, vandalism, possession of weapons or substances, or injury to another camper or staff member, may result in immediate suspension or expulsion at the discretion of Camp Leadership.



> PERSONAL PROPERTY

Please do not send valuable, sentimental, or electronic items to camp. We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged belongings. Prohibited items will be confiscated. Campers should not bring balls from home. Label everything.

HEALTH & SAFETY

> OUR STAFF

All staff are certified in First Aid, CPR, and AED. Every group carries a first aid kit. Our waterfront is staffed by certified Lifeguards and Water Safety Instructors. The camp consults with a licensed pediatric physician for moderate to serious injuries or illnesses. If, for any reason, your camper is injured while at camp, you will be notified.



> ILLNESS POLICY

Please keep your camper home if they have a fever over 100.4°F, or are experiencing vomiting, diarrhea, or an unidentified rash. Campers must be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning. If your camper develops symptoms at camp, we will call you immediately to arrange pick-up.



MEDICATIONS <

All medications must be delivered directly to a staff member in their original container with instructions, along with a completed Medication Authorization Form. Medications are kept locked. We will only dispense Tylenol, Benadryl, or Tums with prior written permission. If your camper requires an epi-pen or inhaler, please send it to camp — it will be kept secure but immediately accessible.

HEALTH & SAFETY

> ALLERGIES

Please ensure all allergies — food, insect, medication, or otherwise — are documented on your camper's health history. Senior Staff review all health histories within the first 24 hours of a camper's first day.



> INJURY OR EMERGENCY

All medications must be delivered directly to a staff member in their original container with instructions, along with a completed Medication Authorization Form. Medications are kept locked. We will only dispense Tylenol, Benadryl, or Tums with prior written permission. If your camper requires an epi-pen or inhaler, please send it to camp — it will be kept secure but immediately accessible.



> WATERFRONT ACTIVITIES

Our beach and docks sit on the Pettaquamscutt River. All campers are assessed for swimming ability before participating and placed in the appropriate level. Life jackets are provided and required for all boating activities.



CAMP GROSVENOR

ARRIVAL, DEPARTURE, AND TRANSPORTATION

> DROP-OFF AND PICKUP

Camp hours are 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM. Please do not drop off before your assigned time. Only people listed on your Authorized Pick-up list may pick up your camper. If you need to authorize someone who is not on the list, send a signed written note, or make a change in your My Club Hub Portal. If your camper is being picked up early, please be sure to send them with a note and give our camp office a call to confirm timing.



> LATE PICK-UP POLICY

Campers must be picked up by 4:30 PM at camp or within 15 minutes of bus stop arrival (unless enrolled in extended care). Families will be charged \$5 per camper for the first 15 minutes late and \$10 for each additional 15 minutes. If we are unable to reach anyone after 30 minutes, the local Police Department and DCYF will be contacted.



> DRIVING TO CAMP

Camp sits at the end of a 1-mile narrow, unpaved access road. Drive slowly — 15 mph on the access road, 20 mph in the neighborhood (exercise additional caution on the road during/after rain storms). Park in the lot before the main entrance. Do not drive past the Buses Only/Stop sign. Walk your camper to the greeting area in front of O'Connell Lodge for check-in and afternoon pick-up.

ARRIVAL, DEPARTURE, AND TRANSPORTATION

> NEWPORT NORTH END STOP, FLORENCE GRAY COMMUNITY CENTER (FGC):

AM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Drop-Off at 8am.
- Bus Departs for Camp Grosvenor at 8:15am
- Parent/Guardians can park on John Chafee or behind FGC in the Met Lot. Once parked, we ask that parents/guardians walk their child to the front entrance of the building near the garden beds to sign their campers in with a BGCNC Staff member. (Pink Circle identifying AM drop-off location).
- **Rainy Day Plan:** Parents/Guardians will come inside the front door to sign-in and drop-off campers.

PM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Pick-up at 4:30-4:45pm.
- Parent/Guardians can park on John Chafee or behind FGC in the Met Lot. Once parked, we ask that parents/guardians line up at dismissal location in the back of FGC on the walkway. (Yellow Circle identifying PM Pick-up location).
- ONLY AUTHORIZED PICK-UPS with VALID IDs will be allowed to sign campers out.
- **Rainy Day Plan:** Parents/Guardians will line up underneath MET overhang for dismissal

> NEWPORT THOMPSON MIDDLE SCHOOL STOP, 55 BROADWAY, NEWPORT, RI 02840

AM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Drop-Off at 7:40am. Parent/Guardian is required to remain with camper to sign them on-to the bus.
- Bus Departs for Camp Grosvenor at 7:45am

PM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Pick-up at 4:30pm.
- ONLY AUTHORIZED PICK-UPS with VALID IDs will be allowed to sign campers out.

> SOUTH KINGSTOWN, 1425 KINGSTOWN RD, PEACE DALE, RI

AM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Drop-Off at 8:30am. Parent/Guardian is required to remain with camper to sign them on-to the bus.
- Bus Departs for Camp Grosvenor at 8:35am

PM STOP:

- Parent/Guardian Pick-up at 4:30pm.
- ONLY AUTHORIZED PICK-UPS with VALID IDs will be allowed to sign campers out

POLICIES & LOGISTICS



> ATTENDANCE & ABSENCES

Attendance is taken daily. If your camper will be absent, please call 401-265-1320 by 9:00 AM.

> REGISTRATION & FEES

- Non-refundable \$25 deposit (per week) is required to hold your camper's slot
- Annual Boys & Girls Club membership: \$30 (required for all campers)
- Families eligible for DHS assistance must provide their certificate number and should use the **DHS Coupon Code when registering: DHSCAMP26**
- Families eligible for Financial Assistance must complete the Financial Assistance application with the appropriate proof of income. Please use the **Financial Assistance Coupon Code** when registering for a discounted deposit amount: **FACAMP26**
- Full payment due 1 week before each enrolled session



> WAITING LIST

Waiting List Registration is first-come, first-served with limited slots per age group. The waitlist is managed through My Club Hub, so make sure to register! Payment is due immediately upon acceptance of any newly opened slot.



> FIELD TRIPS

Permission slips are distributed one week before each trip. Field trips are a privilege — campers who have not demonstrated acceptable behavior may not be permitted to attend.

POLICIES & LOGISTICS



> EMERGENCY CLOSURES

Closures are announced on all RI Broadcasters, as well as our website and phone system. For early closures, Senior Staff will also contact all parents, guardians, or emergency contacts directly. All closure decisions are made by the CEO of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Newport County.

> PHOTOS

We photograph camp activities for newsletters, our website, and marketing. If you do not want your camper photographed, please note it on their application or contact us in writing directly.



> STAFF HIRING & TRAINING

Every staff member undergoes an in-person interview, three reference checks, a criminal background check, and a National Sex Offender Registry check. All staff complete pre-season training covering health and safety, camper abuse awareness, emergency procedures, behavior management, and First Aid/CPR certification. Staff are evaluated in writing twice each summer.



> VISITORS

All visitors must check in at the Camp Office in O'Connell Lodge and receive a visitor's badge.
